PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our August meeting will be the 22nd. Note: there are five Saturdays in the month. The BoD will meet at 7:30am with the regular meeting starting at 10. Trains will be running in between. The theme is: Guess the Heat. Enter by bringing a numbered item. One entry per member. The last 2-3 numbers of the engine or rolling stock will be your guess as to what the heat will be at 11am that day (we call national weather service). The winner is the closest guess to the actual temperature and will get six, free red raffle tickets. In case of a tie, both win six tickets. In case of duplicate numbers, the first one submitted to the secretary gets the number.

Our first ever Summer Cactus Meet was held Saturday, July 25th at the North Phoenix Baptist Center (Bethany Home & Central). We sold 128 tables which is about the same number we sold at the February meet. Channel 10 TV was there for two live broadcasts. In addition, a farmer's market was also being held nearby. Overall, the meet was a success based on feedback from both sellers and buyers.

We do have a slight challenge. We need to do a "post mortem", i.e. analyze the meet to determine how to make it better. We already know we need to re-evaluate the road and building signs to help the public find us. If you were a part of set up, tear down and/or the during the meet activities, please note what we can do to improve and get your thoughts to me or to any BoD member. If you were a buyer and/or seller, how did it go for you? Again, what can we do to make it better?

Initial indications are that the Winter Cactus meet will be even larger thus we want to identify what, where, when, who, why and how we can be better. Our top-of-page billing is "ONE OF ARIZONA'S LARGEST MODEL RAILROAD SWAP MEETS". We have a great reputation within the hobby. Now, how can we improve?

The Central Arizona Model RR Club "Beat the Heat Meet" will be August 15th and the bus is reserved. This year the meet is in Prescott Valley and will be bigger and better cooled. The bus is open to non-members but seating is limited. The cost is just \$30 for adults and \$12 for kids. There is also an optional \$7 bag lunch which will be delivered to you at the meet. 
