#### TEMPE GETS A REAL TROLLEY CAR

PHOENIX — Construction will begin in June on Valley Metro's Tempe Streetcar project after receiving \$50 million in funding through the U.S. Department of Transportation's capital investments grant program. The program is included in the fiscal year 2017 appropriations bill recently signed by President Donald Trump.

Securing additional funds will allow the project to begin construction in early June. When completed, the Tempe streetcar will connect riders to Mill and Ash avenues in downtown Tempe, Rio Salado Parkway, Apache Boulevard, and two light rail stations, in Arizona. The corridor will also include parts of downtown Tempe, Arizona State University, Marina Heights, and the Rio Salado corridor.

In addition to next month's groundbreaking, the agency has also approved Brookville Equipment Corp. to build six streetcar vehicles for the corridor. The agency is still reviewing vehicle paint schemes and design elements.


The \$186-million project is being funded through regional transportation-focused tax measures, other local dollars, and federal grant dollars.

The corridor is on schedule to open in 2020.


